29. ANNUAL CHRISTMAS TEA AND SOCIAL

RESOLVED

- (1) that arrangements be made for the 64th Annual Christmas Tea and Social to be held on 12th December 2015;
- (2) that invitations for catering at the event be sent out in accordance with the approved procedure for tenders, which should be submitted on the following basis:-
 - (a) Option 1 - a salad type meal for those residents attending the Tea and those for collection on behalf of the housebound;
 - (b) Option 2 - a hot Christmas dinner for those residents attending the Tea and a salad type meal for collection on behalf of the housebound;
- (3) that any tenders received shall be opened by the Chairman and/or Vice-Chairman of the Committee at the next meeting to be held on 15th September 2015;
- (4) a strict policy be enforced regarding:-
 - (a) eligibility for the event - only senior citizens who live in Armthorpe qualify and if they are not on the Register of Electors they must produce some form of identification to verify that they live in the village; and

- (b) meals for the housebound - anyone collecting a ticket for themselves should be informed that if he/she is well enough to collect a ticket they are well enough to attend the event and no ticket for collection will be issued in these circumstances;
- (5) that invitations to attend the event be sent to the Civic Mayor of Doncaster, Councillor Paul Wray and his Mayoress, Mrs. Liz Marsden, the Right Hon. Rosie Winterton, M.P., the Rector of Armthorpe and her husband, Mr. Tony Baugh of Next Distribution Limited and his wife/partner;
- (6) that in addition to the Armthorpe Elmfield Band providing entertainment at the event:-
 - (a) the Chairman of the Committee be thanked for her undertaking to ascertain if the Marilyn Baker School of Dance is free to entertain local residents attending;
 - (b) the Clerk ascertain if Mr. Robert Craig, a solo entertainer, would be willing to provide his services at the event;
- (7) that the Chairman of the Council be thanked for his undertaking to contact the local office of Co-operative Funeralcare to ascertain if it will make a donation towards the raffle prizes at the event;
- (8) that the Chairman and Vice-Chairman of the Committee be thanked for their undertaking to purchase raffle prizes for the event in the sum of £400.00 and provide Christmas Hampers as raffle prizes.
