RESOLVED

- (3) that no objections or comments be submitted to the Borough Council in respect of the applications considered (application numbers 18/02311/FUL, 18/02292/FUL and 18/02220/FUL).

77. WARD MEMBERS' REPORTS

RESOLVED that Ward Councillor F.J. Tyas be thanked for reporting and supplying information regarding:-

- (1) Doncaster Borough Council were investigating a complaint that he had passed on to it about an obstruction of the privately maintainable highway, which leads from Whip Hill Lane into the site where two new warehouses are being constructed;
- (2) quad bikes were causing a nuisance around the village and South Yorkshire Police was going to deal with the problem in the near future;
- (3) at a meeting of the Doncaster Sheffield Airport Consultative Committee, it was reported that cargo had increased by 120 per cent this year; both children's rescue and the police helicopters were operating from the airport and 2 Formula 1 racing teams were regularly using the airport;
- (4) the Armthorpe Neighbourhood Development Plan was being reported to a meeting of the full Borough Council on 26<sup>th</sup> November 2018.
