33. WARD MEMBERS' REPORTS

- (1) Doncaster Council had obtained monies from the Sheffield City Region to widen the A630 West Moor Link Road;
- (2) Works to improve/strengthen the bridge on the A630 near to the roundabout at Sainsbury's Supermarket were to be carried out commencing in November 2019 and further details are awaited from Network Rail via the Borough Council;
- (3) Doncaster Sheffield Robin Hood Airport had reorganised all training flights so that none will take place at weekends and flight paths were in the process of being reorganised.

34. SPECIAL MEETING OF COUNCIL

RESOLVED it be confirmed that a Special Meeting of the Council will be held on 25th June 2018 at 7.00 p.m. to consider the Annual Accounts.

35. AIR QUALITY

RESOLVED the contents of an email from Councillor F.J. Tyas and the response received from Doncaster Borough Council regarding air quality in Armthorpe, be noted, which confirmed that:-

- (1) following a complaint about air quality on Doncaster Road, a single simple monitoring tube had been put out to record the levels of nitrogen dioxide and once the results were known, the need to consider further monitoring would be reviewed;
- (2) in the past there had not been a great deal of monitoring of air quality in Armthorpe, largely because it has been screened using traffic data and the proximity of housing to the roadside;
- (3) air quality is assessed against the air quality regulations, which contain objectives with a specific time related exposure period, i.e. an annual average or 1-hour average and there is only one location in Doncaster where a short-term objective is exceeded.
