81. COUNCIL'S ACCOUNTS 2015/16

RESOLVED

- (1) it be noted that BDO LLP had completed the audit of the Council's Accounts for the financial year ended 31<sup>st</sup> March 2016;
- (2) that the Council approve the Annual Return and accept the auditor's certificate at Section 3 of the Annual Return that the information recorded in it was "in accordance with proper practices and no matters have come to our (their) attention giving cause for concern that relevant legislation and regulatory requirements have not been met".

82. PLANNING

RESOLVED that the 3 applications (16/02346/3FUL, 16/02350/OUT and 16/02224/OUTM) submitted to Doncaster Borough Council since the last meeting of the Parish Council, for planning permission to carry out development in Armthorpe, be noted and no objections be submitted in respect of the same.

83. WARD MEMBERS' REPORTS

RESOLVED

- (1) that Ward Councillors T. Corden, C.J. McGuinness and S.L. McGuinness be thanked for reporting and supplying information on the following matters:-
  - (a) Councillor T. Corden stated that he had submitted an objection to the outline planning application 16/02224/OUTM for the erection of residential development of up to 400 dwellings, etc. on land west of Hatfield Lane;
  - (b) it was understood that the owners of Barton Lane were proposing to discuss with officers of the Borough Council a proposal to make a traffic regulation order to prevent parking along that lane;
  - (c) the Borough Council was proposing to make a traffic regulation order to prevent parking along various sections of Tranmoor Lane, Southfield Road, Eastfield Road and Toftstead to ease congestion from traffic dropping off/picking up children attending Southfield School;

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- (d) the Borough Council had agreed to erect CCTV cameras covering the Wickett Hern Road play park and the car park of Armthorpe Rovers Football Club;
- (e) the Borough Council had agreed to replace fencing at the rear of the churchyard of St. Leonard & St. Mary, which would be paid for out of monies deposited with the Borough Council under Section 106 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990;
- (f) confirmation had been received that the Borough Council had served an enforcement notice requiring the removal of the wall and fence erected along the boundary of 37 Fiddlers Drive and that the time for compliance had passed and the owner of the property was likely to be prosecuted for non-compliance.

84. GRANTS TO OUTSIDE BODIES

RESOLVED

- (1) that the contents of a letter from the Armthorpe Senior Group requesting a donation in support of the group's activities, be noted;
- (2) that the Chairman of the Council be thanked for his undertaking to make enquiries of the Seniors' Group for the purposes of establishing if they were a properly constituted voluntary organisation.

85. HIGH SPEED RAIL (HS2) ROUTE

RESOLVED

- (1) that the contents of correspondence from Councillor Cynthia Ransome and Rhonda Job, the Chair of The Joint Rural Parishes, seeking help and support in rallying the residents of Doncaster against the proposed new High Speed Rail (HS2) route, be noted;
- (2) that the Parish Council formally objects to the proposed new High Speed Rail (HS2) route through Doncaster and the petition be signed in support of this objection.

86. FRACK FREE DONCASTER

RESOLVED that the contents of an email on behalf of Frack Free Doncaster be noted, acknowledging that the Council had declined the offer of a presentation about fracking at the present time and supplying details of the dates and venues of forthcoming presentations in the local area.

87. SOUTH YORKSHIRE PASSENGER TRANSPORT EXECUTIVE

RESOLVED that the contents of emails from South Yorkshire Passenger Transport Executive (SYPTTE) be noted, advising that:-

- (1) a consultation on the Future of Supertram will take place between 19<sup>th</sup> September and 30<sup>th</sup> October 2016 on behalf of Sheffield City Region (SCR);
- (2) the consultation will seek views from residents, groups and businesses across SCR on Supertram as a transport option and how the network could be developed or improved to better provide access to work, leisure and education.

88. SALE OF WELFARE LAND, ETC.

RESOLVED that the Regional Manager of the Coal Industry Social Welfare Organisation (CISWO) be invited to a future meeting of the Council to explain (amongst other things):-

- (1) why monies from the sale of land owned by the Armthorpe Miners Welfare Recreation Scheme (the Charity) cannot be utilised on its own local facilities; and
- (2) the relationship between CISWO and the Charity.

89. DMBC - VARIOUS MATTERS

RESOLVED

- (1) that Councillor S.L. McGuinness be thanked for her undertaking to make enquiries of the Borough Council regarding:-
  - (a) the recently repaired street lighting column 21112 situate outside 79 Mansfield Crescent, which is now lit all day; and
  - (b) the position about replacing the wayside seat situate on the footway opposite 96 Nutwell Lane;
- (2) that Doncaster Borough Council be requested to:-
  - (a) take steps to have trees cut back that are overhanging the footway outside 25 Doncaster Road;
  - (b) take action to prevent motor vehicles parking on the footway in Church Street outside the car sales premises;
  - (c) clarify the planning position regarding car sales and car hire on the site of the Mill Street car wash;

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- (d) confirm whether the water authority requires planning permission to undertake development (which involves piling) on its land in Holmewood Lane;
- (e) explain the source of the water which intermittently gushes through the drain/sewer running along Oakwood Drive, which can be heard in the vicinity of the manhole cover situate outside the properties of 24 - 26.
