124. PLANNING

RESOLVED that the 6 applications submitted to Doncaster Borough Council since the last meeting of the Parish Council, for planning permission to carry out development in Armthorpe, be noted and no objections or comments be submitted in respect of the same, namely, application numbers 18/00093/COU, 18/00095/FUL, 18/00083/FUL, 18/00120/FULM, 18/00105/FUL and 18/00145/OHL.

125. PARKING OUTSIDE SCHOOLS

RESOLVED

(1) that in order to alleviate the problems caused by unauthorised vehicular parking in the vicinity of the premises of the Southfield and Shaw Wood Academies, Doncaster Borough Council be requested to:-

- (a) ensure that Traffic Wardens visit these areas on a more frequent basis at school opening and closing times to take action against drivers of offending vehicles;
 - (b) consider removing wherever possible grass verges to create additional vehicle parking spaces; and
 - (c) arrange for a bus stop to be removed from Tranmoor Lane, which is situated just past Eastfield Road and have it re-sited to what residents describe as a "cut out area", that is approximately 60 metres away on the same side of the road;
- (2) that South Yorkshire Police be requested to pay attention to these areas with a view to taking action for any offences of obstructing the highway, leaving engines running whilst parked and noise nuisance from loud music played in stationary vehicles.

126. DMBC - VARIOUS MATTERS

RESOLVED

- (1) that the contents of an email from Doncaster Borough Council be noted, confirming:-
- (a) it is aware of the crater in the carriageway surface of the Doncaster Road railway bridge and it is already marked up for patching pre-surface dressing, however, it is below the monthly inspection intervention criteria;
 - (b) a definite date cannot be given as to when the patching and dressing will take place but it will be monitored monthly in case it deteriorates further;
- (2) that the contents of an email from a resident of Wickett Hern Road regarding the emptying of a dog bin situate between 41-43, be noted;
- (3) that the Borough Council be requested to:-
- (a) re-site the dog bin situate between 41-43 Wickett Hern Road to a more suitable location (not outside a residential property) and in the meantime empty the bin on a more frequent basis as its contents overflow and cause a smell nuisance;
 - (b) repair the defective lighting column which lights up the pedestrian crossing on Doncaster Road (Spa Supermarket side of the road);

- (c) require the ornamental grass situate in the garden of 30 Tranmoor Lane to be cut back as it is overhanging the footway and causing a nuisance to pedestrians;
- (d) clear the blocked surface water drain situate in the car park at Jenkinson Grove;
- (e) arrange for a stop tap cover missing from outside 70 Walbank Road to be replaced;
- (f) arrange for a gorse bush situate in the open space at the junction of Mansfield Crescent and Park Avenue, which is overhanging the highway to be cut back;
- (g) arrange more frequent collections of blown litter on the grass verge opposite the Household Waste Recycling Site, Armthorpe Road;
- (h) repair the area around a dropped surface water cover situate in the highway around the roundabout at the Nutwell Lane/Church Street/Mill Street junction.

RESOLVED that the contents of an email received from Mr. D. Ransome, expressing an interest in applying for co-option to the recent casual vacancy in the office of Councillor, be noted as the matter will be considered at the next meeting of the Council.
