 - chronic (long-term) respiratory diseases, such as <u>asthma</u>, <u>chronic obstructive pulmonary disease (COPD)</u>, emphysema or <u>bronchitis (external link opens in a new window / tab)</u>
 - chronic heart disease, such as <u>heart failure</u>
 - <u>chronic kidney disease</u>
 - chronic liver disease, such as <u>hepatitis</u>
