There is additional support available to Armthorpe residents through APEC the Armthorpe Charity for those in need, hardship or distress. A separate application would need to be made for consideration by Trustees.

APPLICATION PROCESS & REFERRAL SYSTEM

Armthorpe residents may apply directly, see below, if you require help applying, we will accept referrals on their behalf from Agencies, including Doncaster Community Hub, Schools, Family Support, Friends, Families and Neighbours. We are keeping the application process and referral system as straightforward as possible to try and ensure a quick response.

Only Armthorpe Residents will be eligible, those identified as vulnerable, aged over 70 years, unable to get out and experiencing difficulty accessing food AND individuals/families whose employment has been affected and had their income reduced as a result of Coronavirus (Covid-19) Pandemic.
